



Middlewich Town Council Grant Guidelines 2020

Please read our Middlewich Town Council Grant Guidelines below

1. WHO CAN APPLY?

Middlewich Town Council will accept applications from:

- Registered charities, not for profit organisations, statutory organisations, local schools, voluntary groups and CICs (Community Interest Companies)
- In exceptional circumstances, those organisations not based in Middlewich but who are providing projects or services within Middlewich will be considered for a grant as long as it can be demonstrated that it is of benefit to local residents.

Middlewich Town Council will not accept applications from:

- Private individuals.
- Limited companies. However, if it can be demonstrated that the project is a not-for-profit project and forms part of a scheme to benefit local residents it may, in exceptional circumstances, be considered.
- Organisations with only one bank account signatory.
- Organisations who exclude anyone for reasons of sex, race, disability or religion unless it can be demonstrated that the project or service is allowed to provide a restricted service e.g. Women's Refuge facilities.
- Organisations who provide a service that is already supplied by another organisation within Middlewich town unless it can be demonstrated that there is a local need for more than one service of its type.

2. WHAT CAN YOU APPLY FOR?

Middlewich Town Council is flexible on what the funding can be used for but good examples of what will be given priority include:

- A grant towards stationery and materials for projects or events/regular meetings/classes
- Funding for equipment
- Room hire fees and overheads (excluding wages and personal expenses)
- Transport costs
- Refreshments/beverages
- Set up contribution costs for new, beneficial groups who will be located within Middlewich

3. WHEN CAN YOU APPLY?

Applications are considered by the Internal Committee who meet the first Tuesday of each month.

Please send your full application at least 2 weeks prior to your chosen submission date
